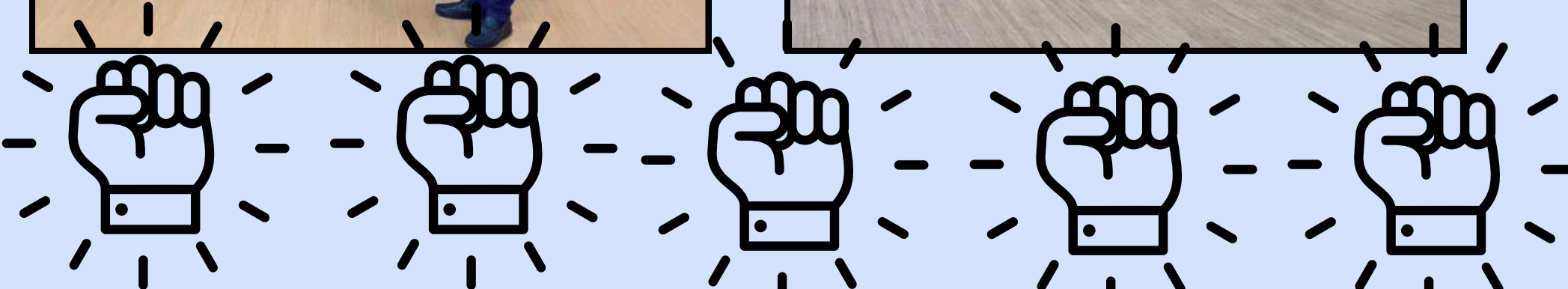
# The Passing of the Torch: Honouring a Legacy and Welcoming a New Era

# A New Chapter Unfolds



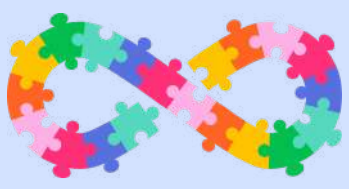
We are delighted to welcome our new Principal, **Mr. Lalit Mohan Sharma**, to the Jagannath International School family!

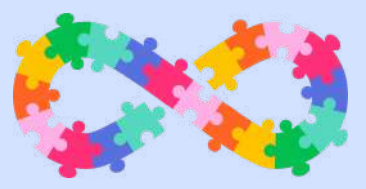

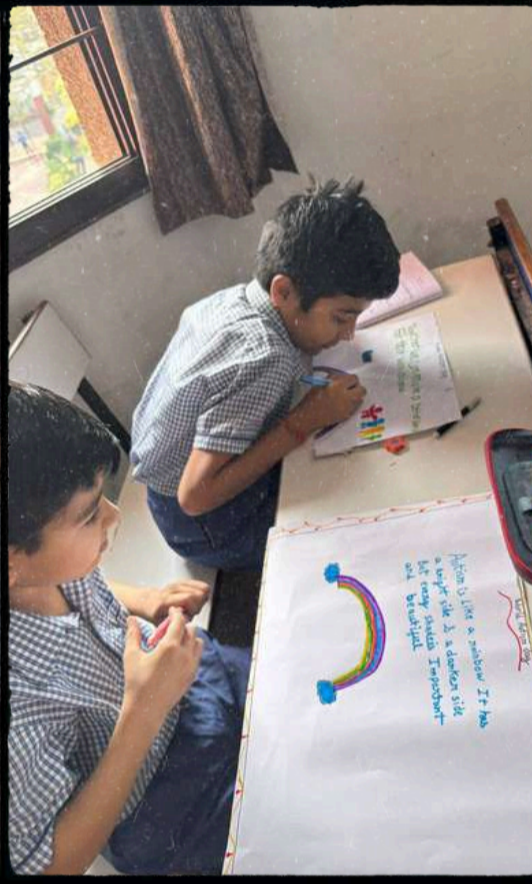
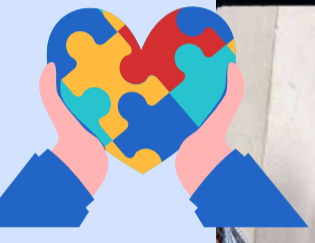


# World Autism Day

The little ones had a wonderful time exploring the creative corner, enjoying refreshing Chhabeel, and celebrating with lively music, dance and masti.



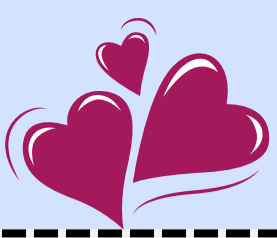
# Special Assembly - Baisakhi

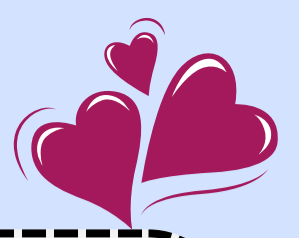

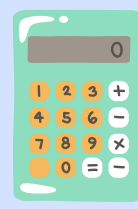
# ATL Community Day Workshop

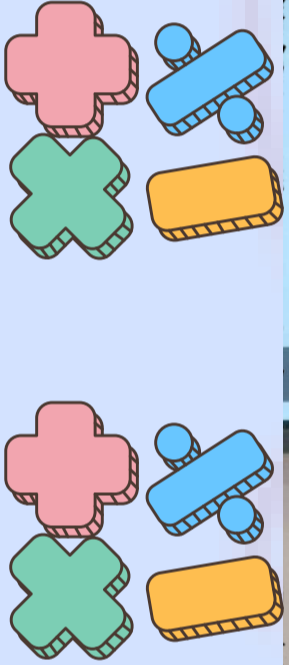




# Math-O-Fun Activity

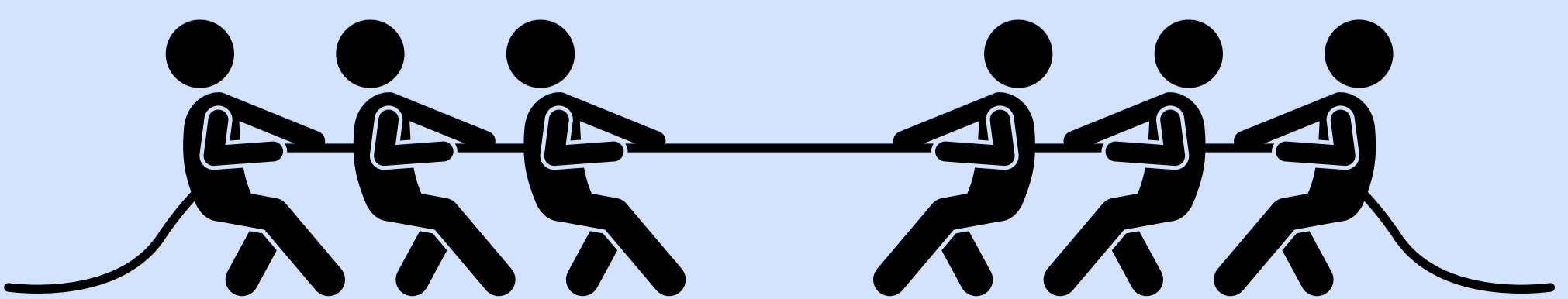

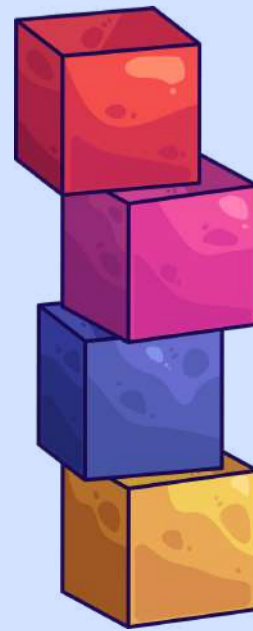
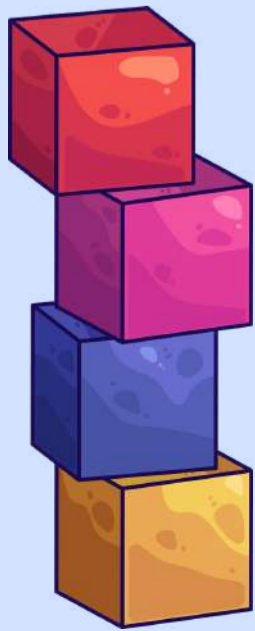




# Sort and Stick Activity

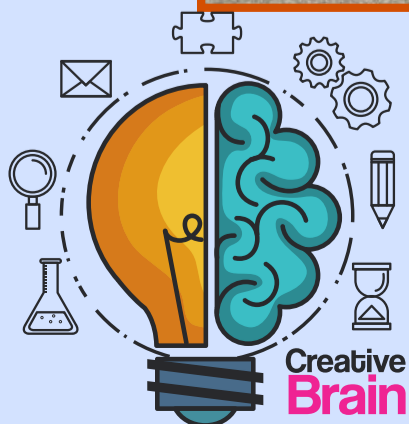




# Learning Beyond the Classroom

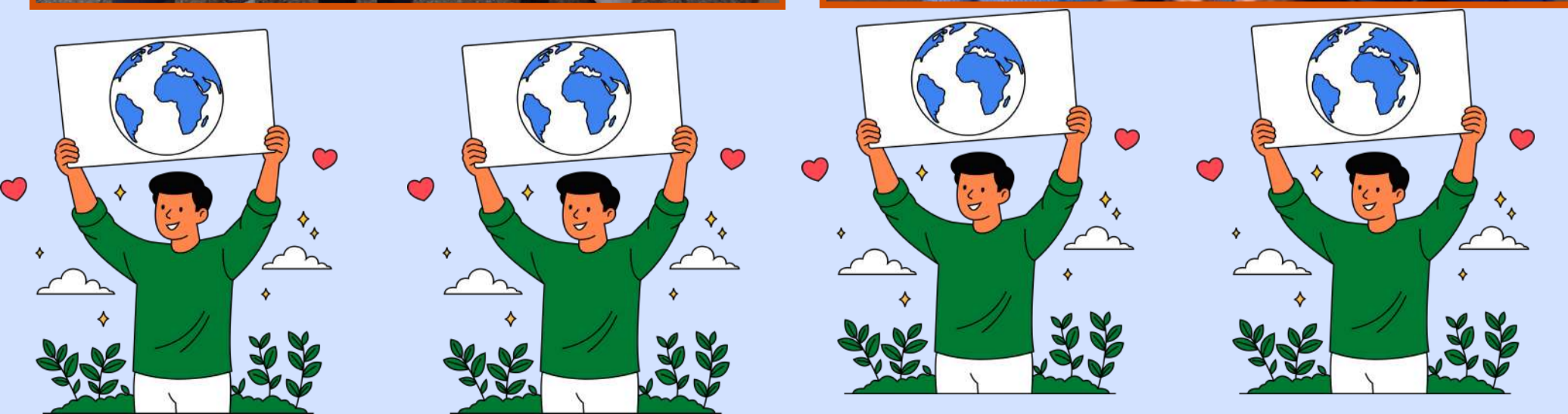
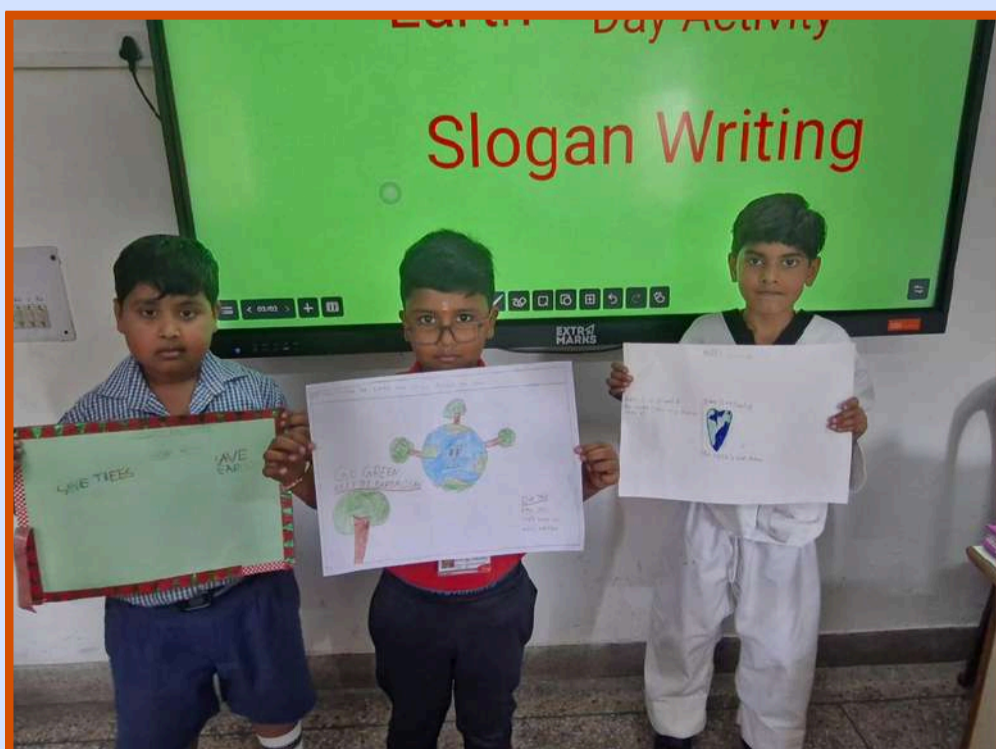
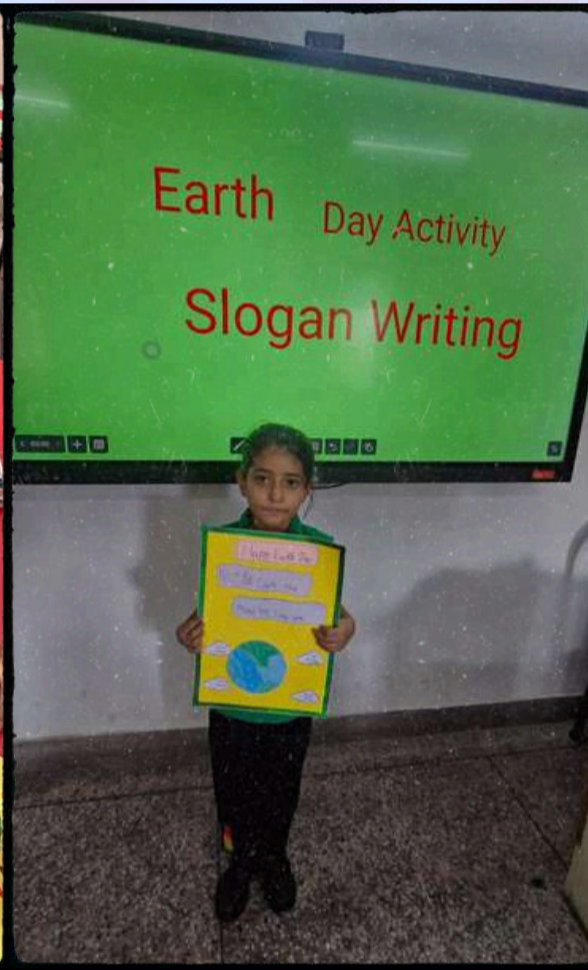




# Earth Day Celebration

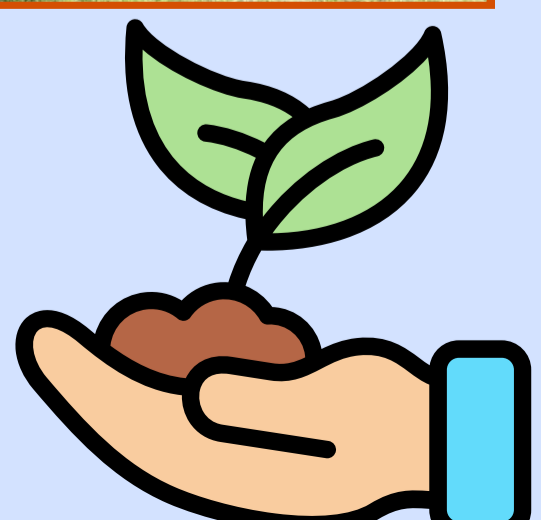
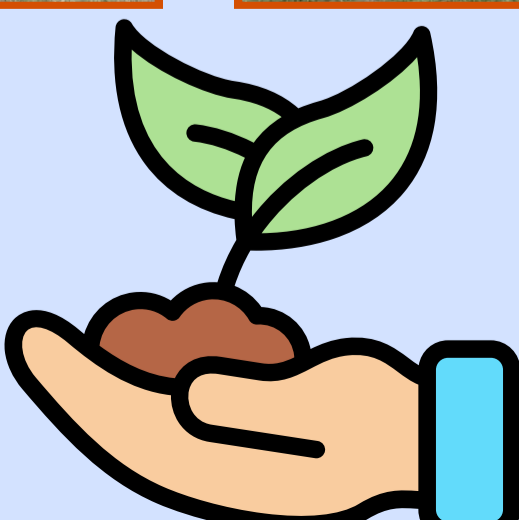
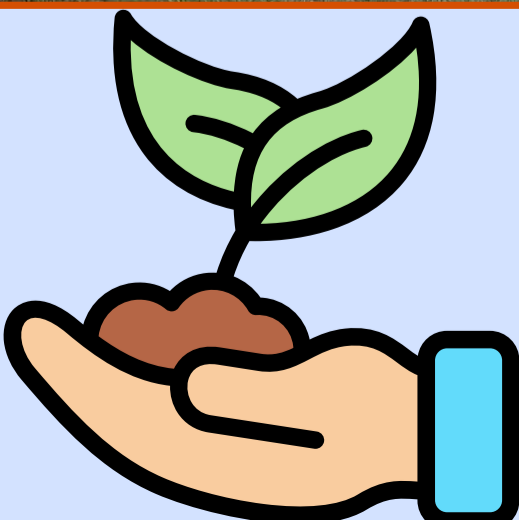




# Seed Bomb Activity

# **Learning by doing makes Science Exciting**

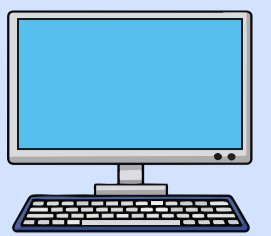

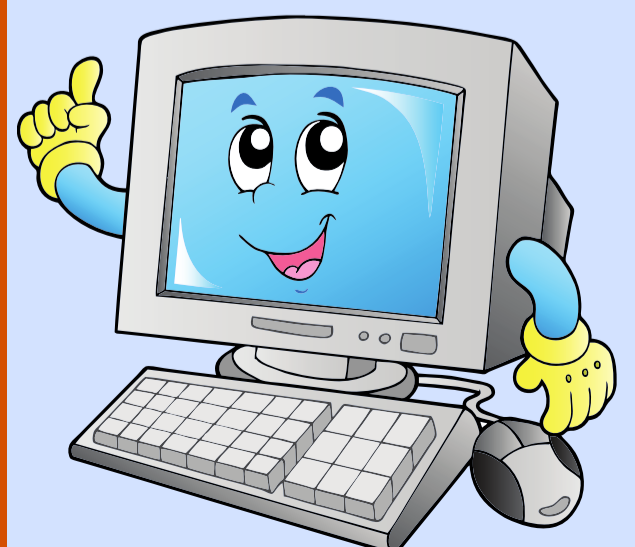




# Orange Global Olympiad

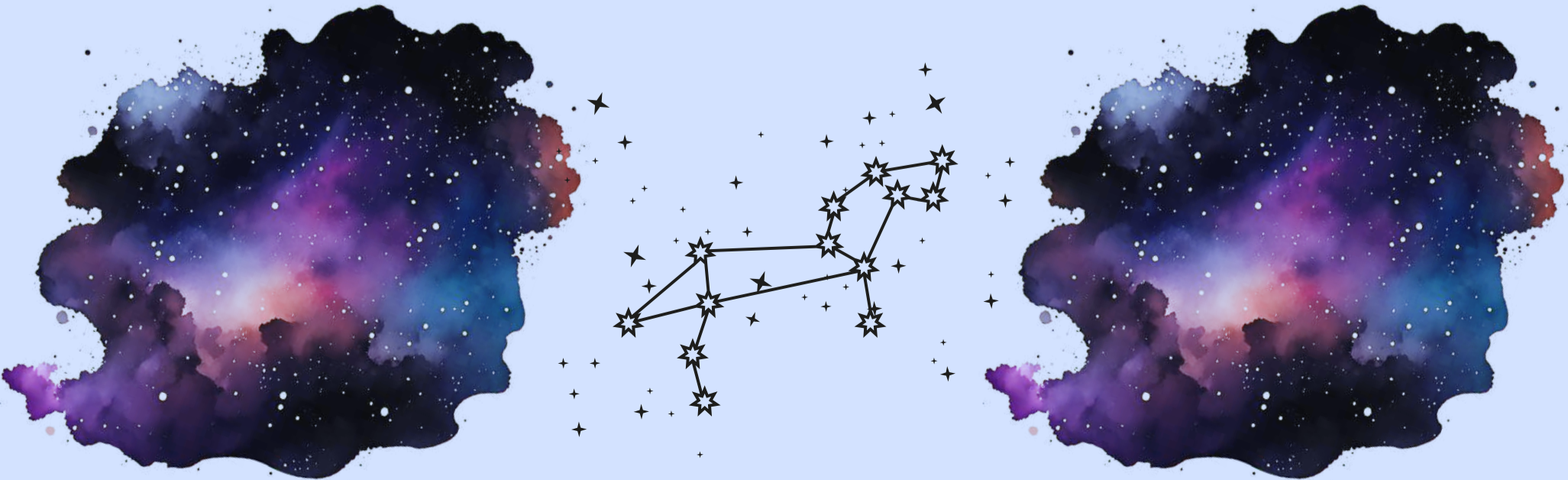
# Say No to Plastic - Writing Competition

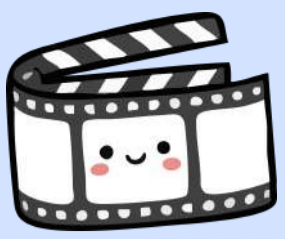


# Little Hands, Big Imagination

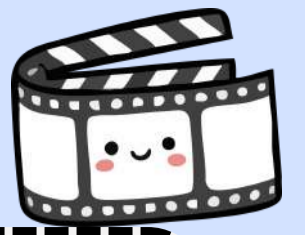

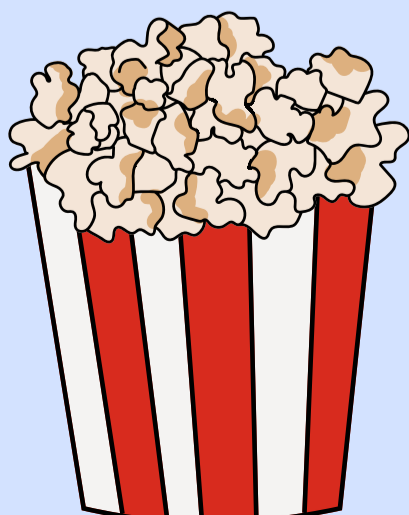
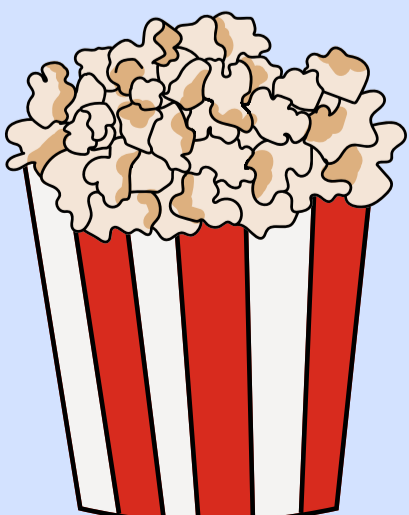




# A Magical Movie Day

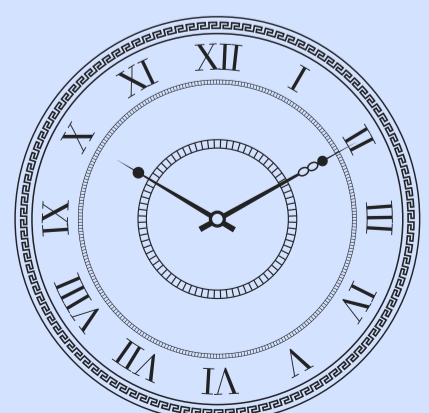
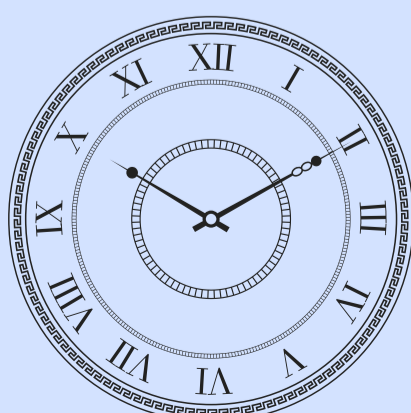
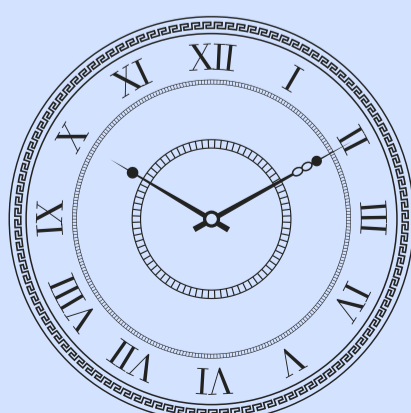
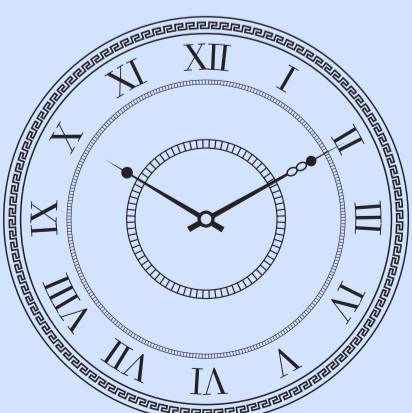
# Labour Day Celebration

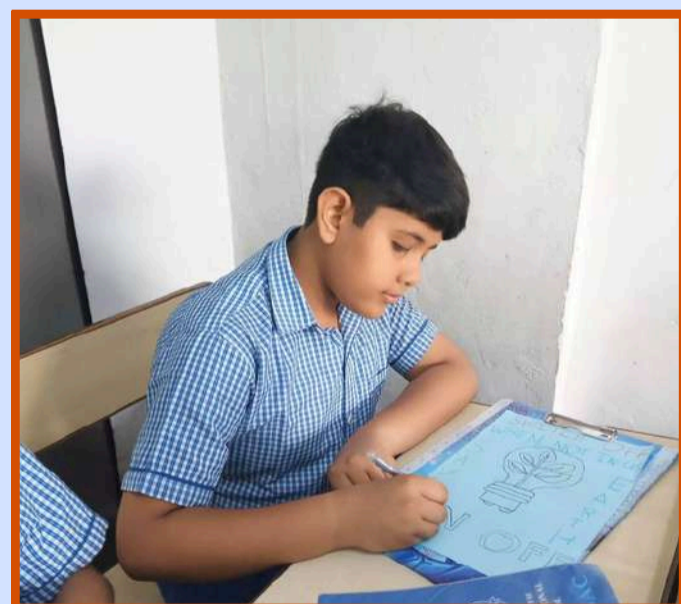
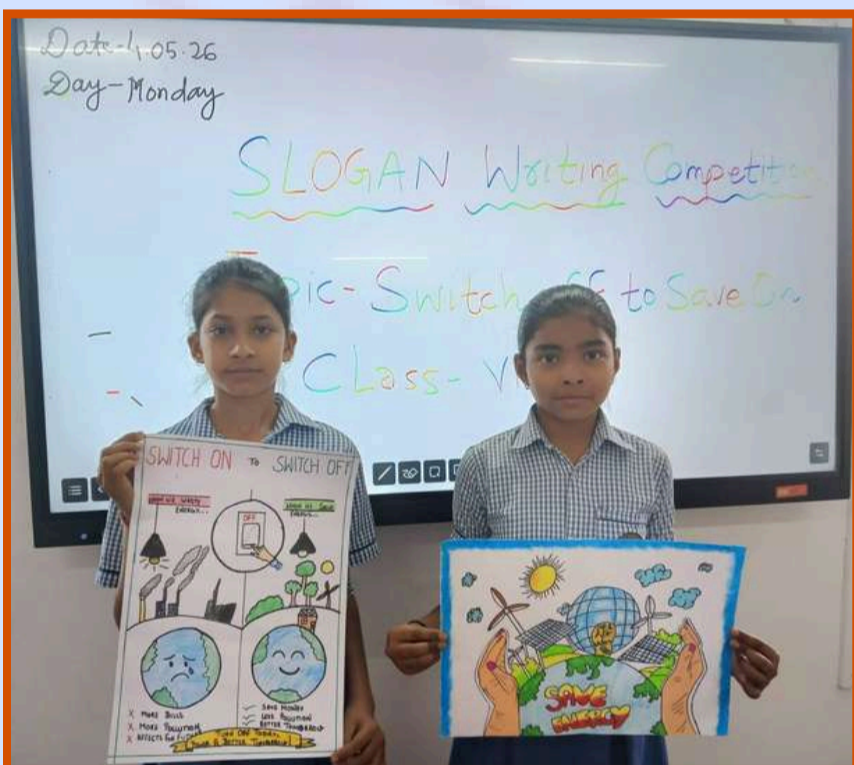


# Slogan Writing Competition

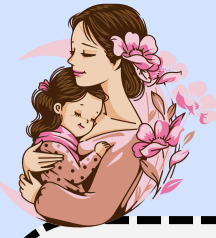
● **Day 1 (May 6th):** The Seniors (Classes IX–XII) took the stage, bringing a level of intensity that kept everyone on their toes.

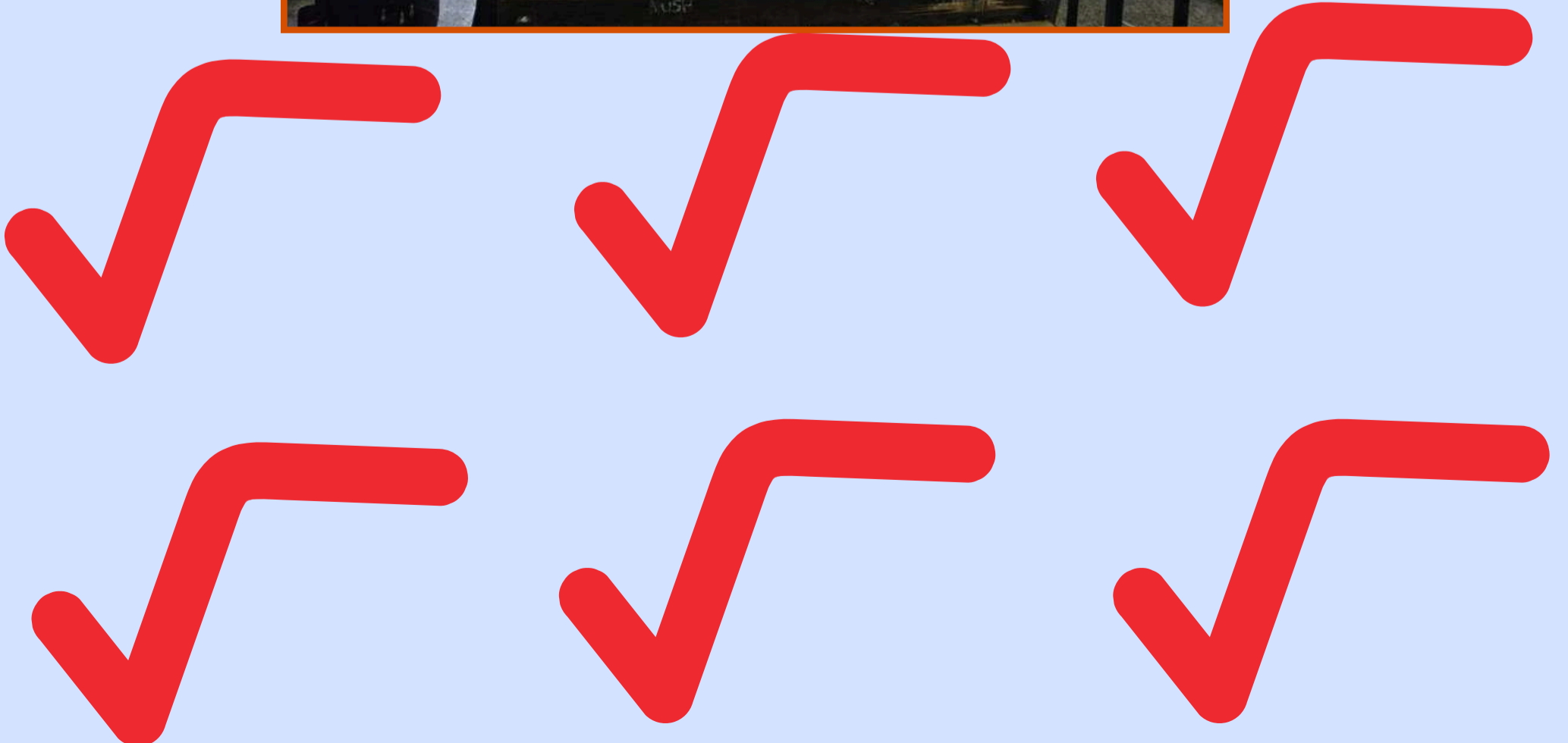


# Perfect Squares Activity

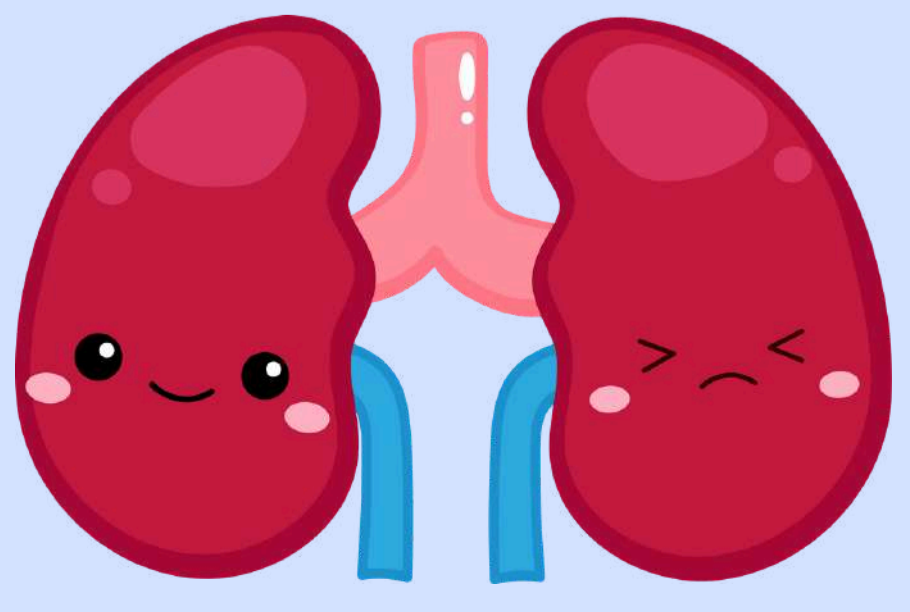
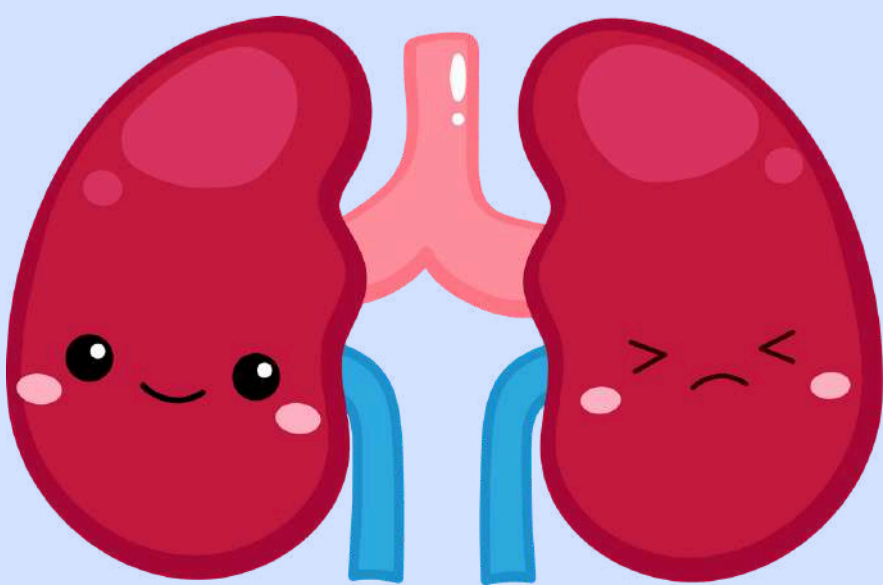
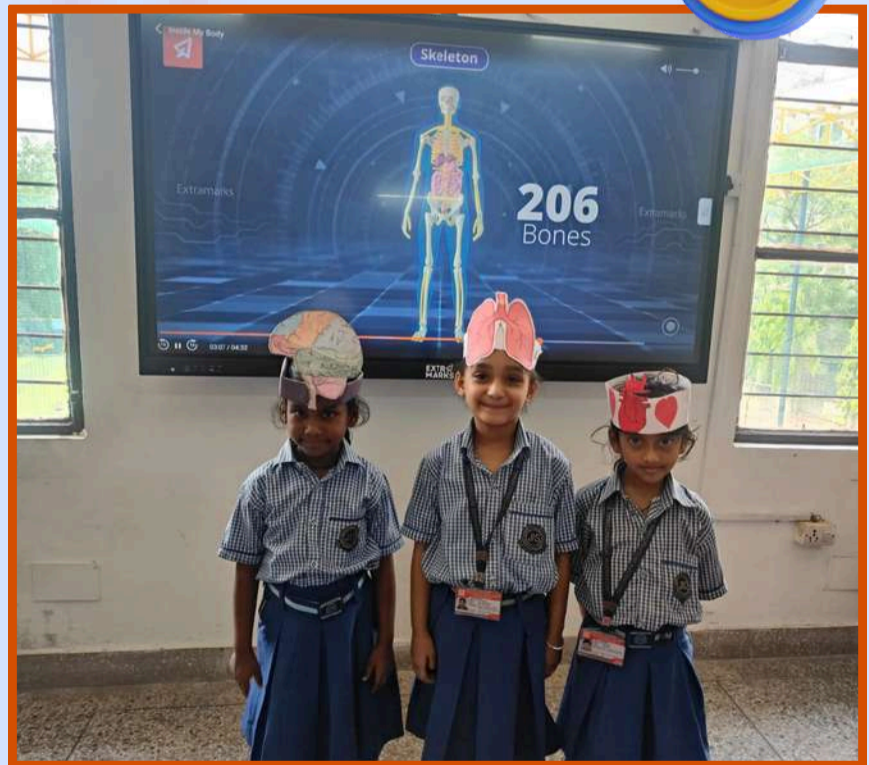
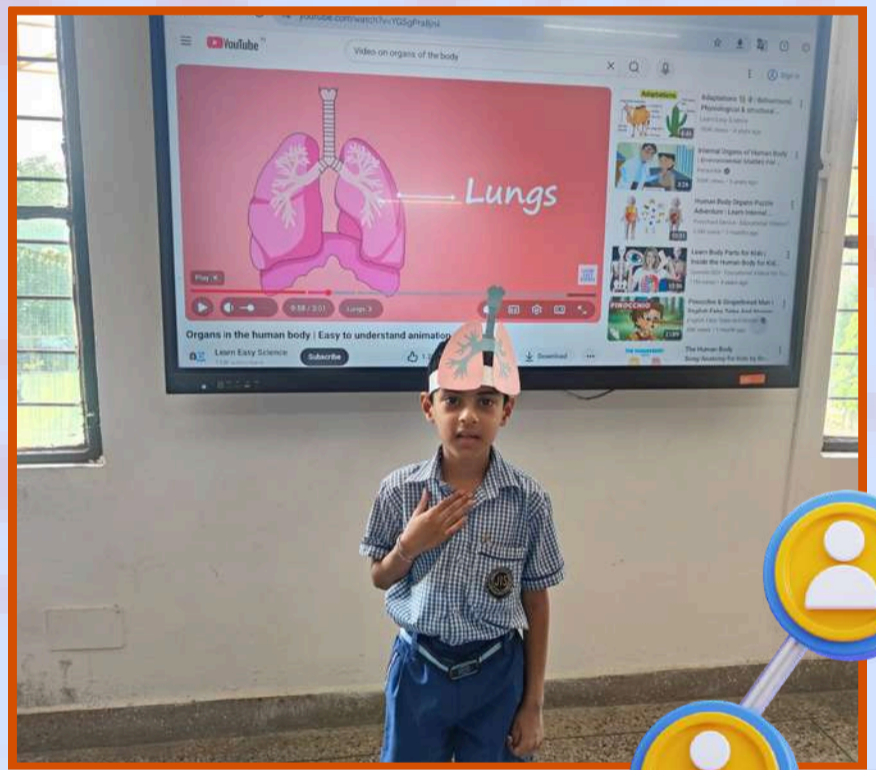
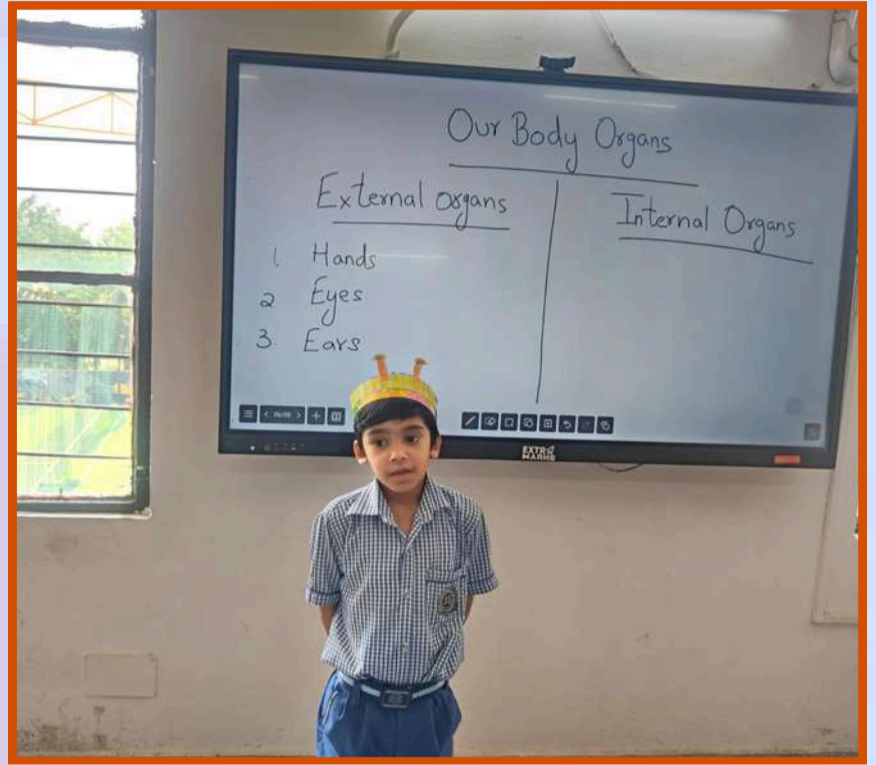
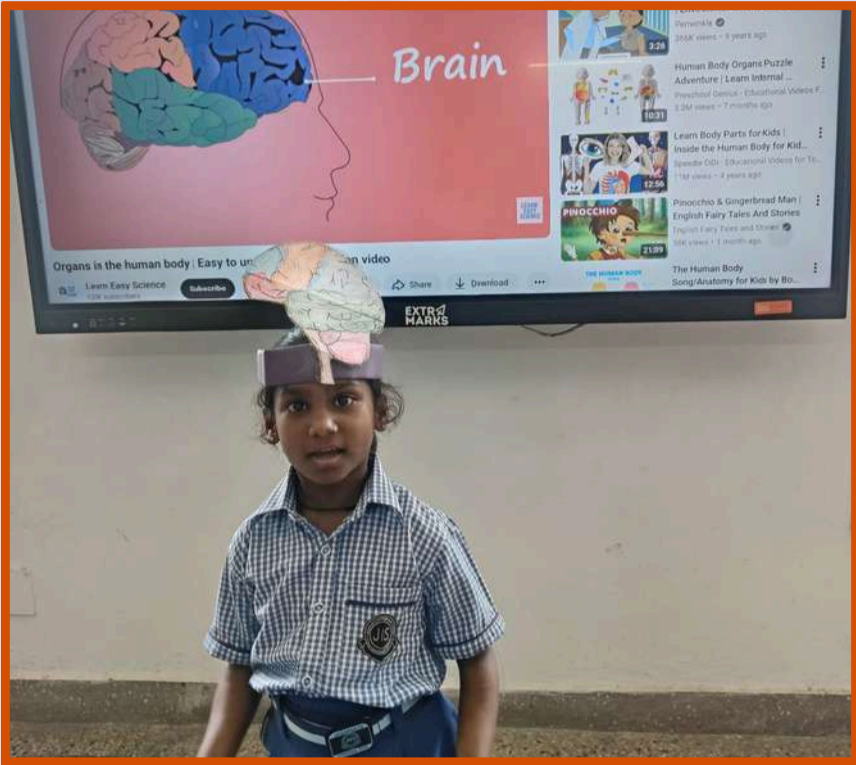




# Organs of the Body
