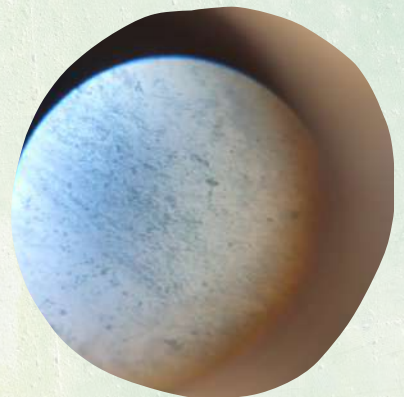


# Science is fun

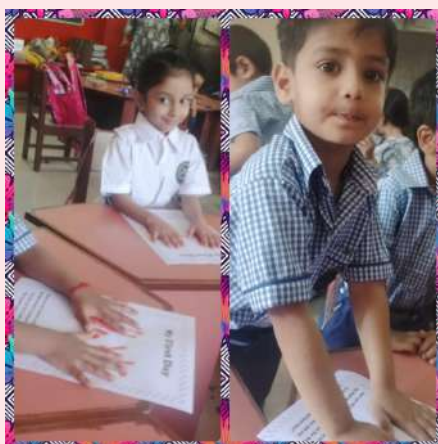
# WELCOME DAY

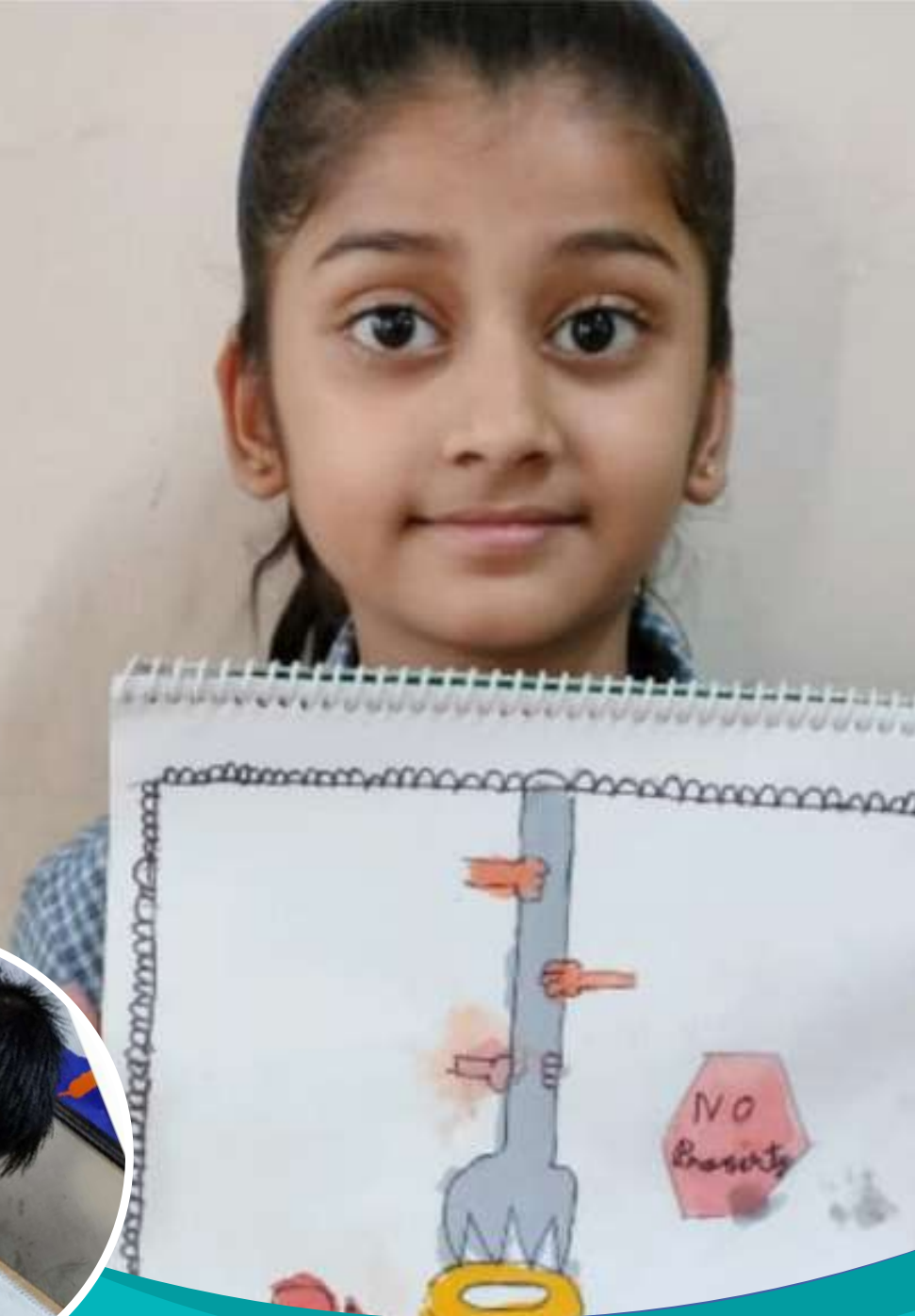

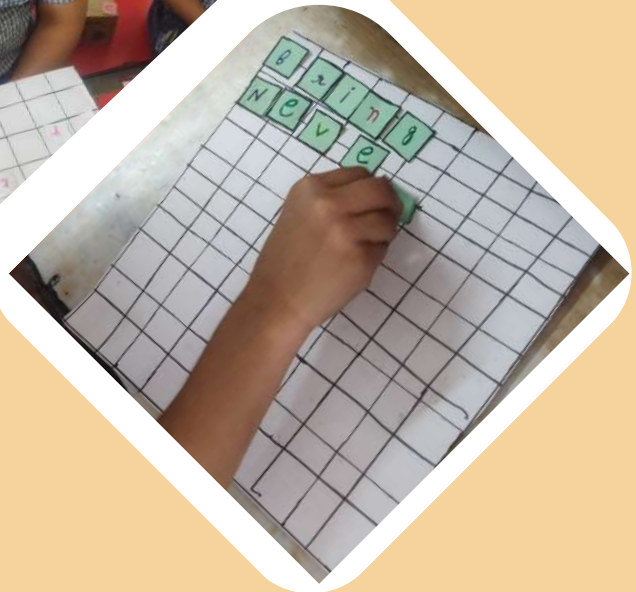
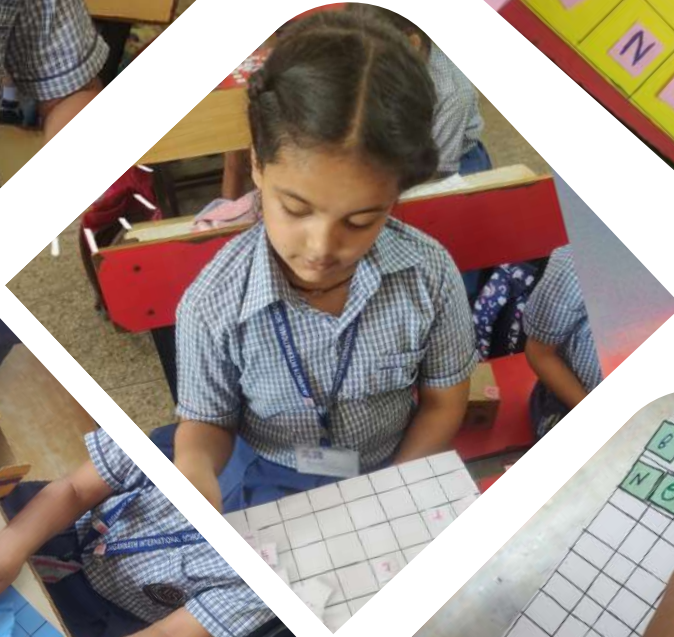


# NO POVERTY

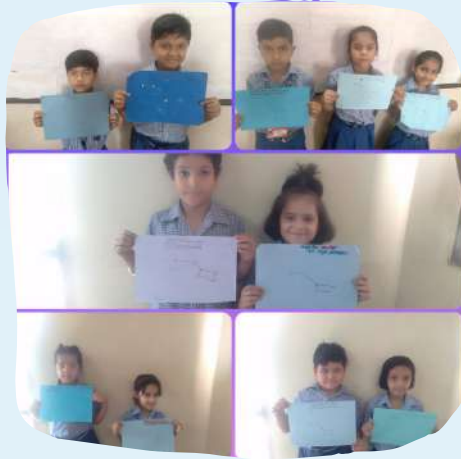
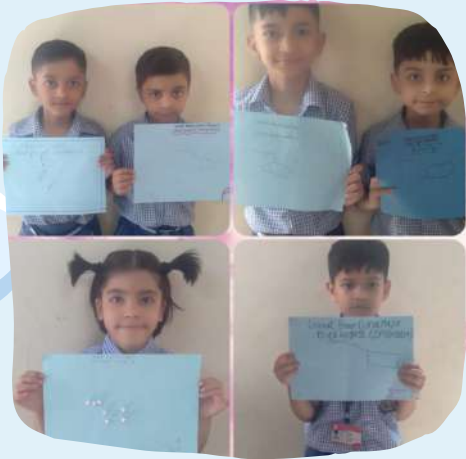


# SCRABBLE TIME
