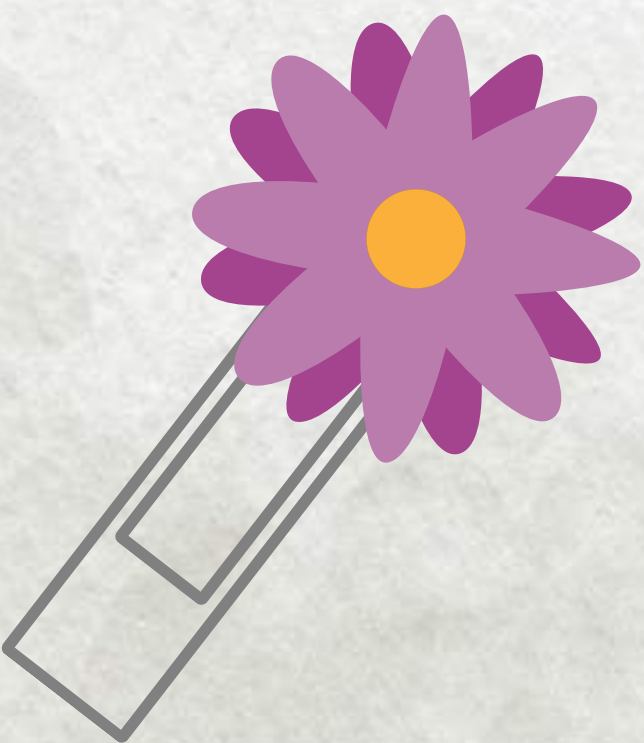
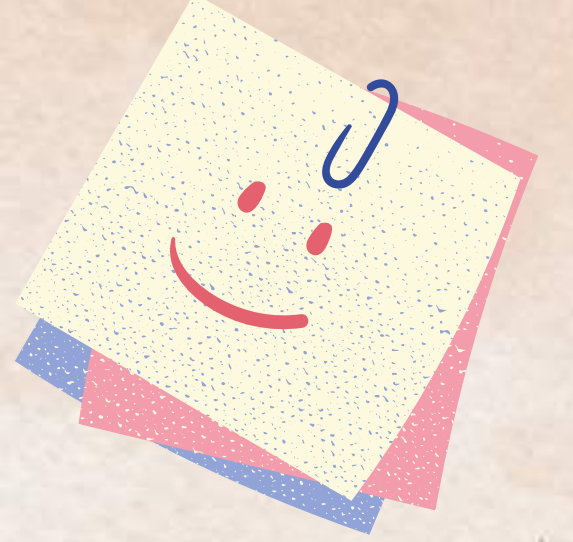
Letter H - Hat Day Activity.

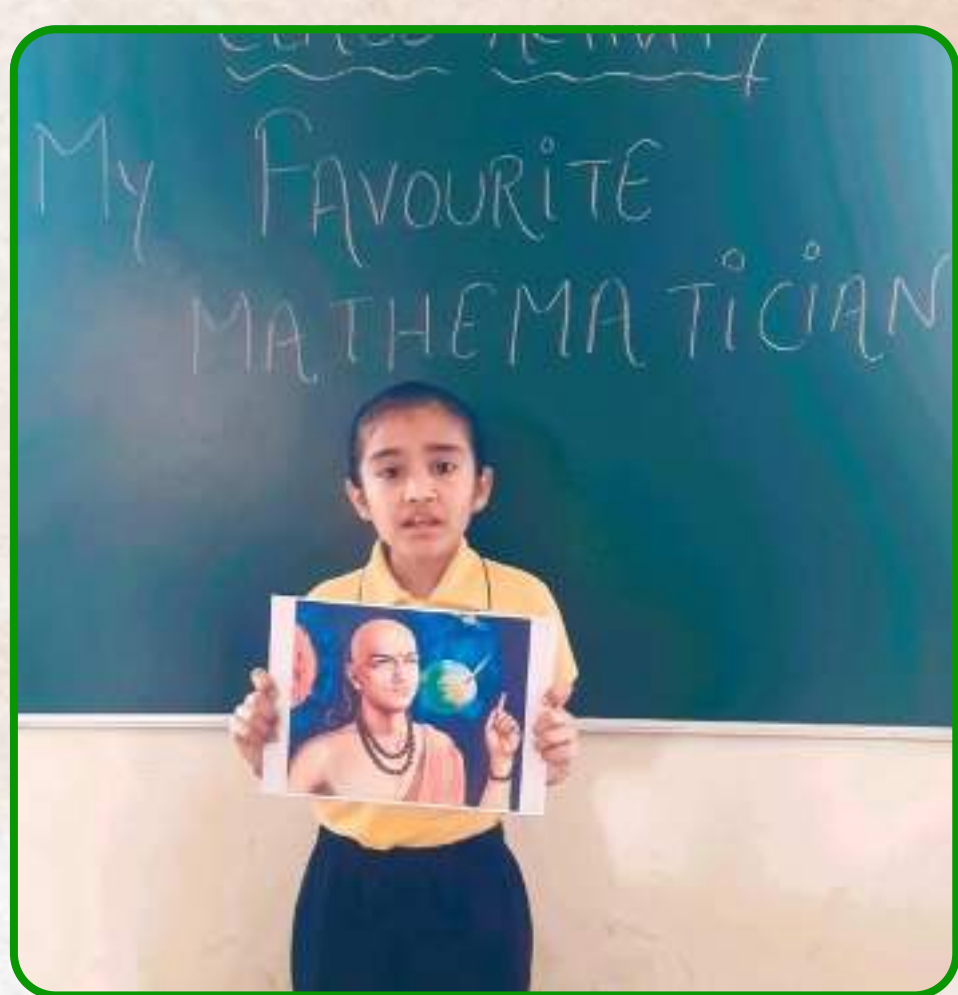
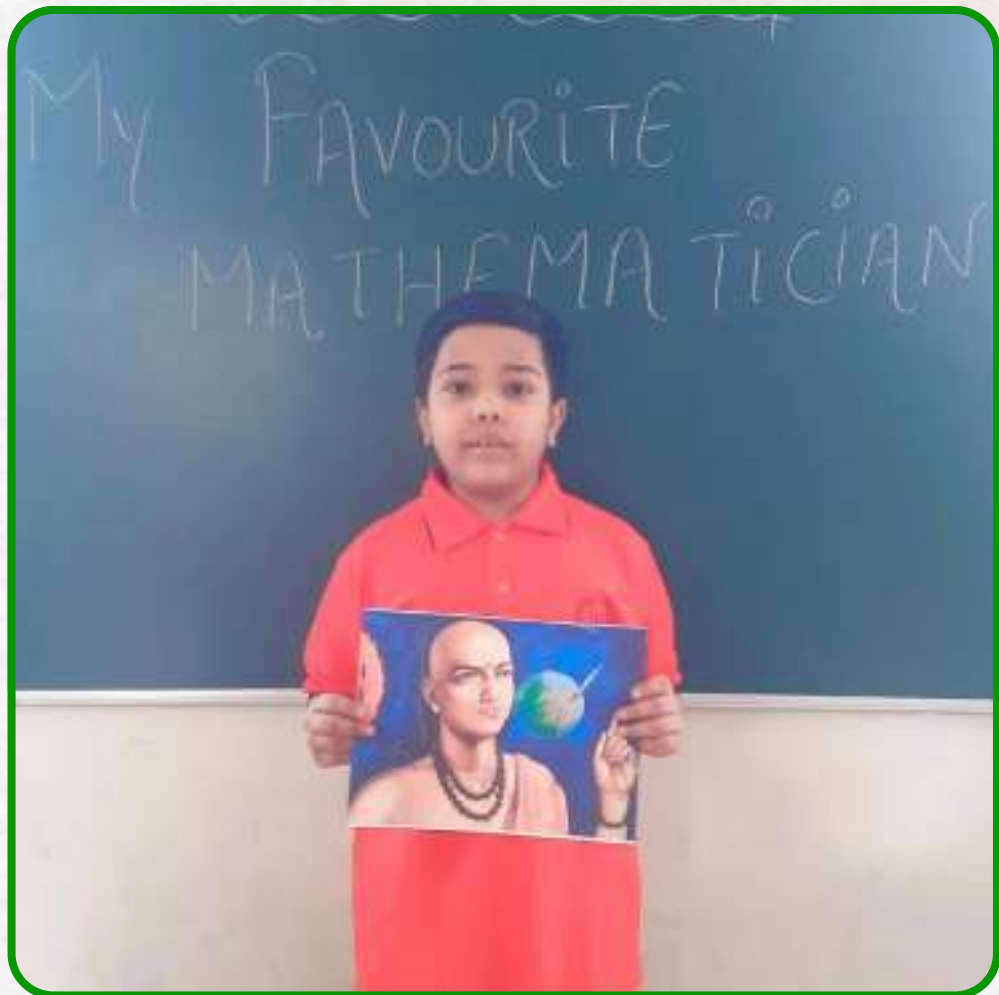


Global Adventure

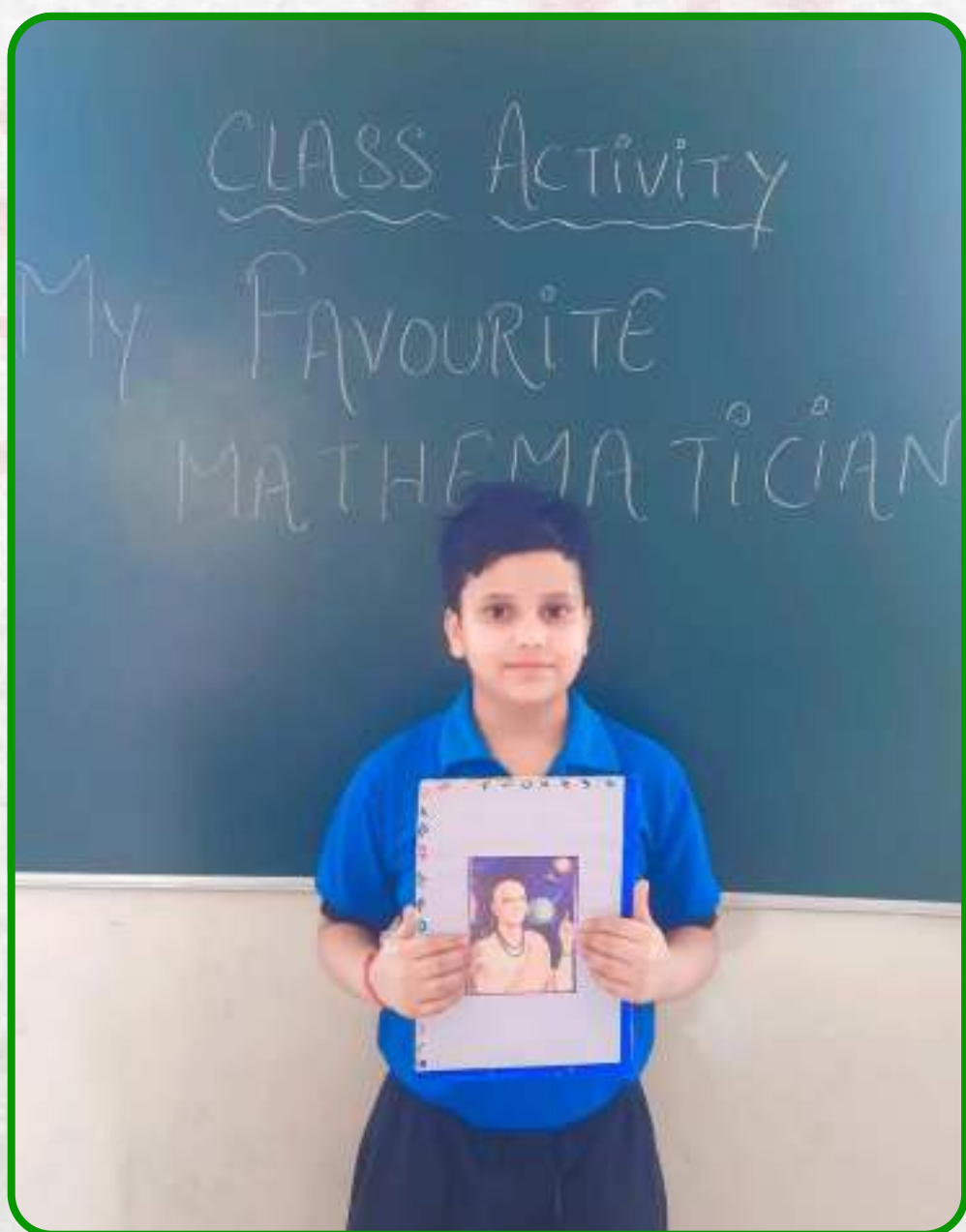
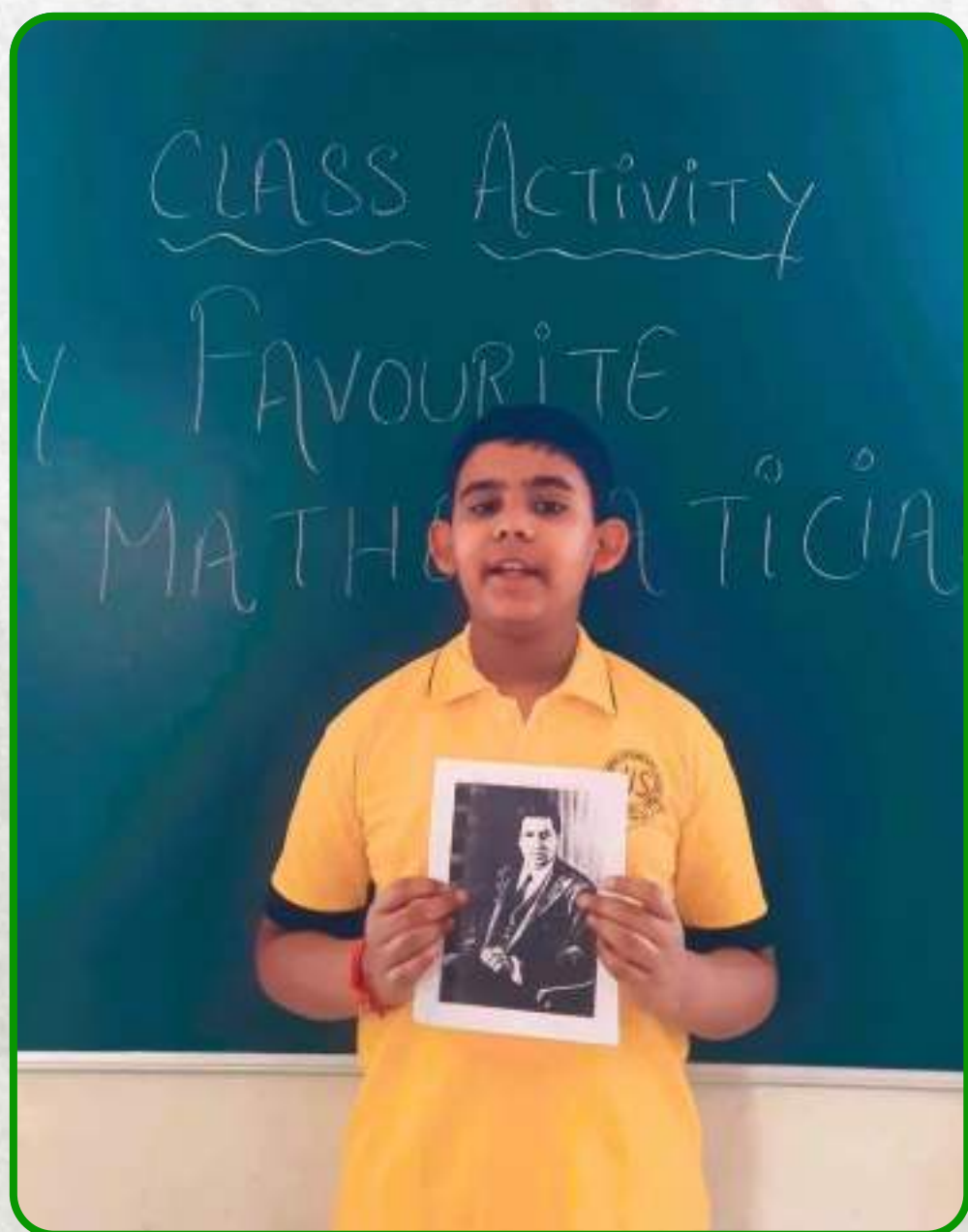


My Favourite Mathematician

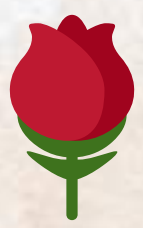


Super Solar: Model Making

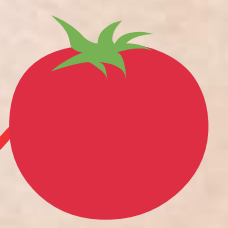
Group Activity

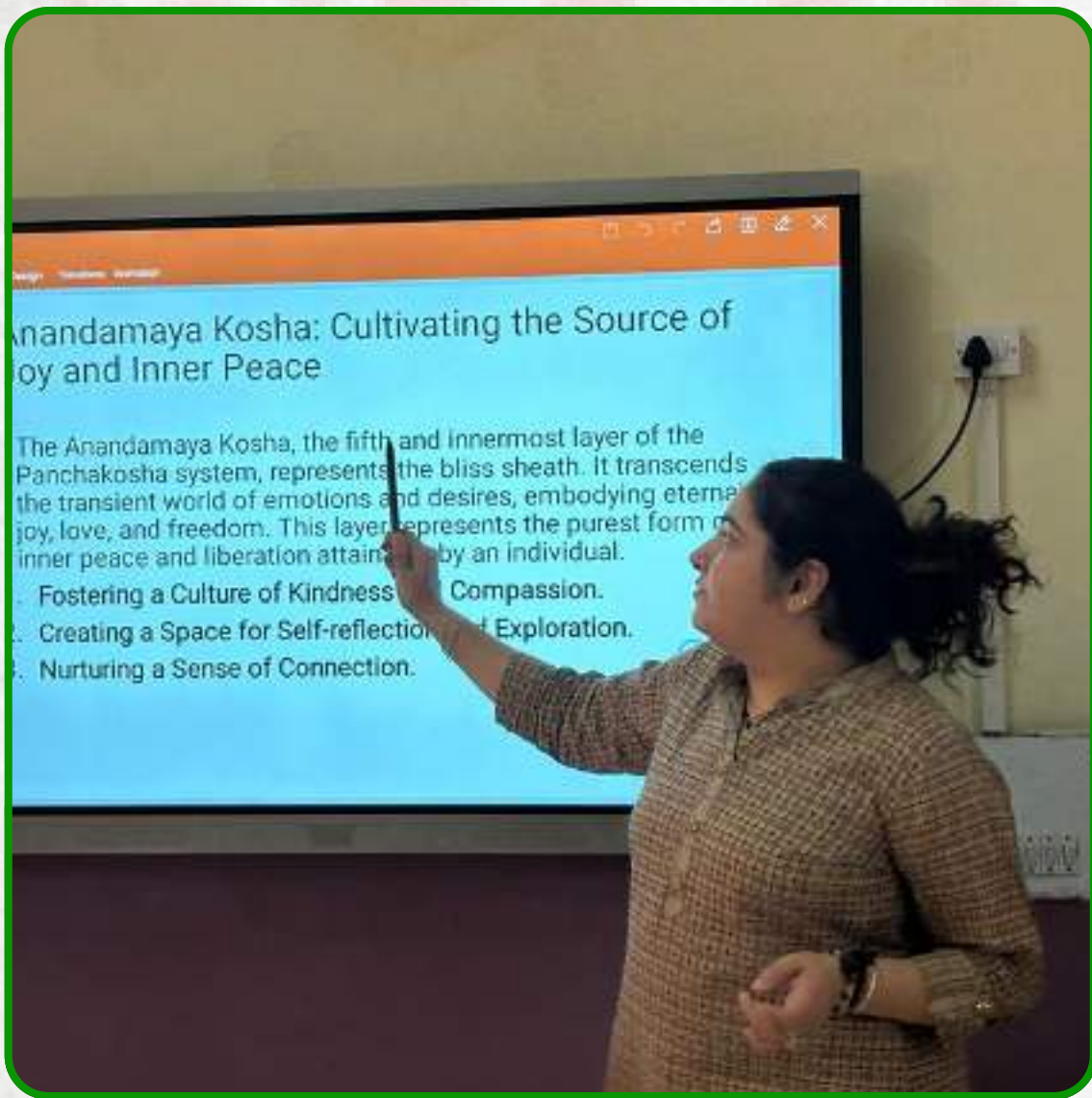


Balvatika and Jadui Pitara

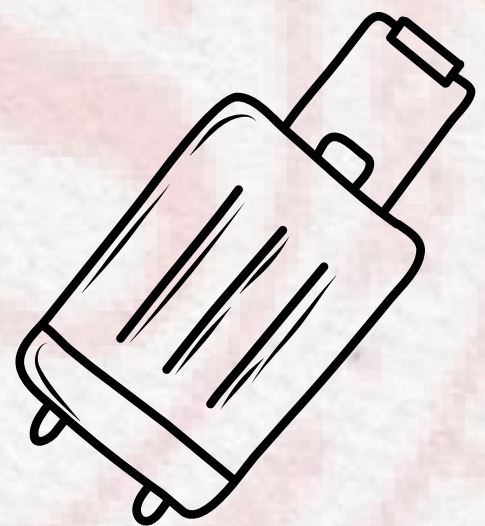

FUN WITH HOOPLA

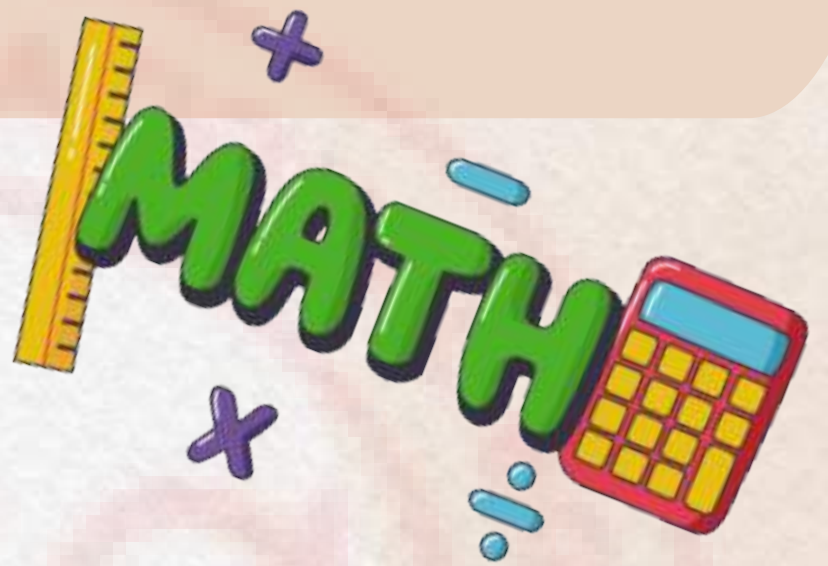
